

**SPORTING CHANCE  
MINUTES  
SPECIAL MEETING CALLED BY PRESIDENT STEVE PIPER  
May 31, 2005**

President Steve Piper brought the meeting to order at 7:10 p.m. on May 31, 2005.

**WATER SKI EVENT**

Cindy from NDAD met with the Sporting Chance group to review the upcoming Water Ski Event which will take place on July 16 & 17, 2005 at Lake Nelson. Discussion was opened and the following areas were reviewed:

**Pontoon:** Bob reported that the pontoon will definitely be ready for the Ski Event. He will be getting it ready on Wednesday for the Fishing Event this weekend.

**Water:** Dan Johnson advised Cindy to contact Nicole at Great Plains for water. If anyone has any other contacts for donations of water, please let Cindy know.

**Ice:** Cindy asked if anyone knew a business that would donate ice for the ski event. Dan said we have always bought the ice from Rud's in Center. We can pick it up as needed. We really don't have any place to store the amount of ice we need for three days if picked up in Bismarck. Cindy agreed and we will continue to pick up the ice locally.

**Jet Skis:** Moritz Marine was a bit reluctant to offer the use of a jet ski this year. Steve, Dan & Ray will check with acquaintances to try to round up the jet skis that we will need.

**Patriot:** The Patriot will be ready for Lake Nelson and Ray will try to acquire another one.

**Tents:** Cindy will have the tents at the Lake by noon on Friday.

**Food:** Cindy reported that NDAD had decided to have the meals scheduled this year because the participants were eating continuously and it became too expensive. Breakfast will be from 8:00 to ??? and lunch from 11:30 to 1:30. Snacks will be available before and after the lunch and breakfast.

**FISHING EVENT**

**Pontoon:** Bob Gibbons reported that the battery is dead. Needs new battery. Dan Johnson moved that the Sporting Chance purchase a new pontoon 24 Series battery which is a good starting battery @ 50 + horses – will run around \$60.00. Bob Gibbons seconded the motion and it passed.

**Camper:** Bob Gibbons also reported that the camper needs a new battery. Dan Johnson suggested and made a motion that the Sporting Chance purchase a new battery of the 27 – 29 Series which should run around \$75 - \$80. The motion was seconded by Bob Gibbons and approved by the club.

**Boats:** Steve Piper reported that 20 to 21 boats have been committed. It doesn't appear that we will get a pontoon from Enable this year. Steve also reported that we have about 40 – 50 participants.

**Bait:** We will get the bait from Landers, Unistop, and Pony Express. Steve Piper will pick up the bait.

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**Ice:** Diana will pick up the ice at B & J – ordered 15 bags of ice.

Camper needs cleaning: It will be at Wades – Lot 96 – Pipe, Diana, Robert will clean the camper and anyone else who can help on Wednesday night.

**Equipment:** Rods & reels – will work on them Friday night out at camp.

**Registration:** Start at 8:00 a.m., Saturday. Steve will get name tags, registration, releases.

**Food:** Connie will order potato salad and macaroni salad from Country House Deli and pick it up. (Will pick up enough for 125 + people) Bob Gibbons has approximately 6 gallons of Chile left from his Promotion Steve will get the bowls and spoons. Connie will pick up cookies for dessert. Adam is in charge of hamburgers and hot dogs/brats. Steve will get the buns. Ketchup and mustard??? Bob has lots of pop left from promotion. Chips need to be picked up.

Connie will bring a “church cooker” for the Chile. The Camper has one “church cooker” in it for the brats and hamburgers.
